Remember that Frederick Douglass, a formerly enslaved man, spoke to a crowd of mostly white, free men in New York city in 1852. From the language he used, we know that his words cannot be considered endearing, excluding A, or docile, excluding E. Choice D doesn't quite describe the tone of that speech either. Now that the choice is narrowing to B or C, think about what is most correct. C is not the most correct because of the word justified. While his anger may seem justified to you, there is no way to know whether his listeners felt the same way as asking the question. In fact, during this period of time, it can be argued that many probably do not. They most likely describe him as a passionate and accusatory one of them and the United States as a whole, making Choice B the best answer. 2. The choice is too narrow, since the barbarism of America, as it relates to the rest of the world, is only really described in a few sentences in the text. The choice of C is too wide. Gross inequality can describe inequality between races, genders, ages, religions, political views, etc. D does not mention American Independence Day and Choice E is not mentioned in the passage. B is the correct answer because he summarizes Douglas's point on the Fourth of July by answering a question he poses in the title of his speech. 3. What Douglas State he doesn't have to prove to the audience? A. That the popularity of enslavement with their help will decrease. These enslaved people can do the same amount of work as free men.C. This enslaved people are a man. This enslavement is divine. It is wrong to compare enslaved people with animals. The right choice is C. This is a difficult question because Douglas asks a lot of questions and says that he doesn't need to answer them, but then answers them anyway. However, he never mentions Choice A, so it can be ruled out. He also never declares B, although he lists the various jobs that enslaved people all do. He claims the reverse choice of D and although he mentions that animals are different from enslaved people, he never says that he doesn't need to prove that the comparison is wrong, as E would mean. He did, however, that he doesn't need to prove that people people because the laws have already proven it and no one doubts it. Therefore, Choice C is the best answer, as it is the only clearly stated one. 4. Based on the passage, all the following reasons Douglas said that he would not argue against slavery EXCEPT: A. The essence of the paragraph in which the fact was expressed was that the law proved that the enslaved person was the person, but Douglas included those statistics for other reasons as well. He also uses it to educate the audience about the dreaded tidbit of Virginia's little-known law, to not only show one of the countless gross inequalities between free men and enslaved people, but also to support his main point: Fourth of July is not Independence Day for all. Grouping multiple sheets in Microsoft Excel Grouping sheets together in Excel can be useful if you have an Excel work book with multiple sheets that contain different data but follow the same layout. Three sheets have student lists for different classes, called Class A, Class B, and Class C. If we group these sheets together, any actions we perform on any of these sheets will be applied to all of them. Simply click and hold Ctrl, and then select the sheets you want to remove from the group. The tabs of the sheet that you ungroup will return to the gray background.
